

RESOLUTION 2014-48

A RESOLUTION BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GRIFFITH AUTHORIZING THE USE OF FRANKLIN CENTER PUBLIC PROPERTY FOR PRIVATELY SPONSORED HOLIDAY DISPLAYS BY TEMPORARY PERMIT

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Griffith is interested in responding to public request for a designated area available for privately sponsored decorative displays in celebration of state and nationally recognized seasonal holidays; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the foregoing, the Town Council desires not to endorse or sponsor any particular display or type of display so that any holiday display should be clearly marked by its private sponsor and must be cost neutral to the Town of Griffith;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Griffith, Lake County, Indiana, that the Town does hereby authorize the use of the area directly in front of the Franklin Center for privately sponsored holiday displays from November 13 up to and including the 10th day of January, provided the following:

That the display be erected after application and receipt of permit therefore from the office of the Clerk-Treasurer of the Town of Griffith and approved by a member of the Town Council;


That each display shall contain a clearly visible sign identifying the private sponsor of the display by individual or organizational name; and


That any display requiring use of available electrical access or other available utility shall require a fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00) be submitted to the Clerk-Treasurer with the application to offset the cost to the Town;


That the prefatory paragraphs above are incorporated herein by reference as if fully restated herein;




